***How my life has changed since I won the talent contest***

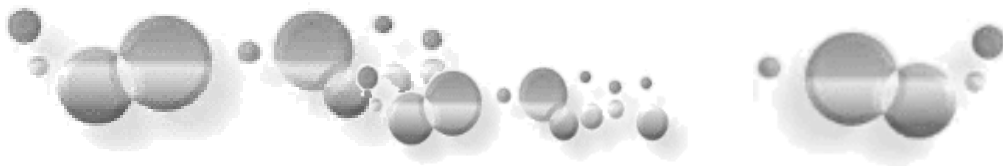

**How my life has changed since I won the talent contest?**

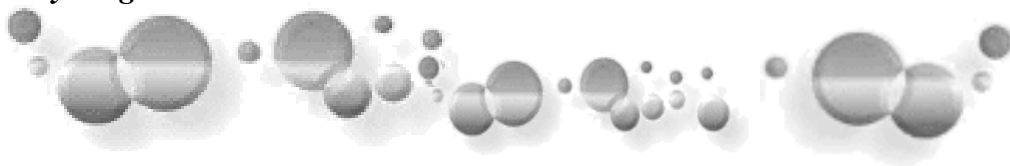
