

經済與創新

繼承與創新是相輔相成的,沒有繼承,創新就無從談起;沒有創新,繼承也不過爾爾。無論在甚麼時候,創新是必不可少的,但是缺少了繼承,創新便會成為無源之水,無本之木,正所謂「飲水思源」也正是這個道理。

創 新 , 並 不 是 所 謂 的 閉 門 造 車 , 不 是 靠 自 己 的 主 觀 而 隨 意 編 造 的 , 而 是 要 注 意 繼 承前人優秀的成果,在別人正確的理論指導 下, 創新才會顯得更有意義。藝術要在繼承 的基礎上創新,書法和其他藝術一樣,貴在 不斷推陳出新,在學習與借鑒前人經驗的基 礎上,創造出富有時代精神的新作品。晉代 的王羲之,被譽為「書聖」,他學習書法不 但刻苦認真,而且博採眾長,不斷擴大自己 的知識層面。他起初向衛夫人學習書法,後 來又借鑒秦漢以來眾多的書法佳作,秦代李 斯、漢代蔡邕、三國鍾繇等許多名家作品, 他泛覽博識,然後才創造出一種俊逸妍美的 新書體。他的代表作《蘭亭集序》被譽為「天 下第一行書丨、《樂毅論》則被譽為「千世 楷書之祖一。可見繼承與創新是密不可分的, 只有在取得其精髓去其糟粕的繼承中,創新 才是最可取的。



相反,盲目的繼承往往會弄巧成拙,讓 人傳為笑談。就像那「邯鄲學步」的鄭國人, 總想學習別人的步伐,以便自己跟本國的人 走路不一樣,似乎是創新了,但是動機不純, 方法不對,不懂因時制宜,弄巧反拙,落得 了爬回去的下場。可見繼承也要深得其法。

繼承和創新是魚與水的關係,沒有了繼承如同只有魚沒有水,再好的創新也會成為空中樓閣,不會有長久的生命力;而只有水沒有魚,則會表現出只有繼承沒有創新的死寂空洞,毫無生氣。只有將魚和水放在一起,才會顯得生機蓬勃;只有創新和繼承結合一起,才會結出成功的果實。


職業不分貴賤,才能不分職業,北大高材生毅然選擇賣豬肉,最終營業額達兩億,成為 一代名人巨商。



As students, we certainly face some stress but some have it more than the others. What is the source of stress at school? And what is the solution to it? Those things are what I am going to tell you.

There are different sources of stress, but mostly it is about studies and parents' expectation. The most stressful students are most likely the F.6 students because they have to take the DSE exams. They have to obtain at least Level 3 for Chinese and English, and Level 2 for two electives so as to get a chance of winning a ticket to university. That's why there is a lot of news of DSE candidates committing suicide.

Parents usually expect their children to work hard and be the best. Some reasonable parents will not blame their kids for bad results if they have worked hard enough. However, some may just judge their children by their results and say something hurtful. Lack of communication makes it worse as the only thing students hear from parents is their yelling. This absolutely heightens students' stress level.

Some sources of stress are only known by

I hope that you will find a way to deal with the stress with the suggestions given and let us hope that the atmosphere in schools will become happier.




