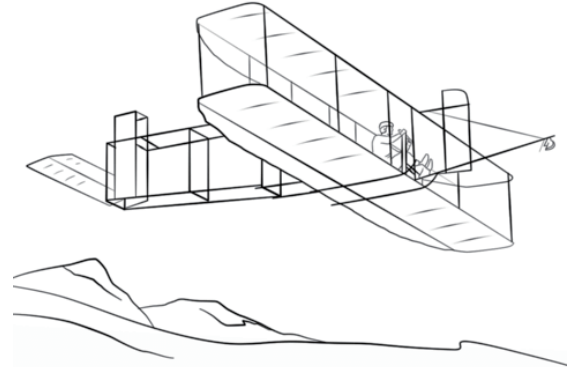

# 最偉大的發明



# 餃子
